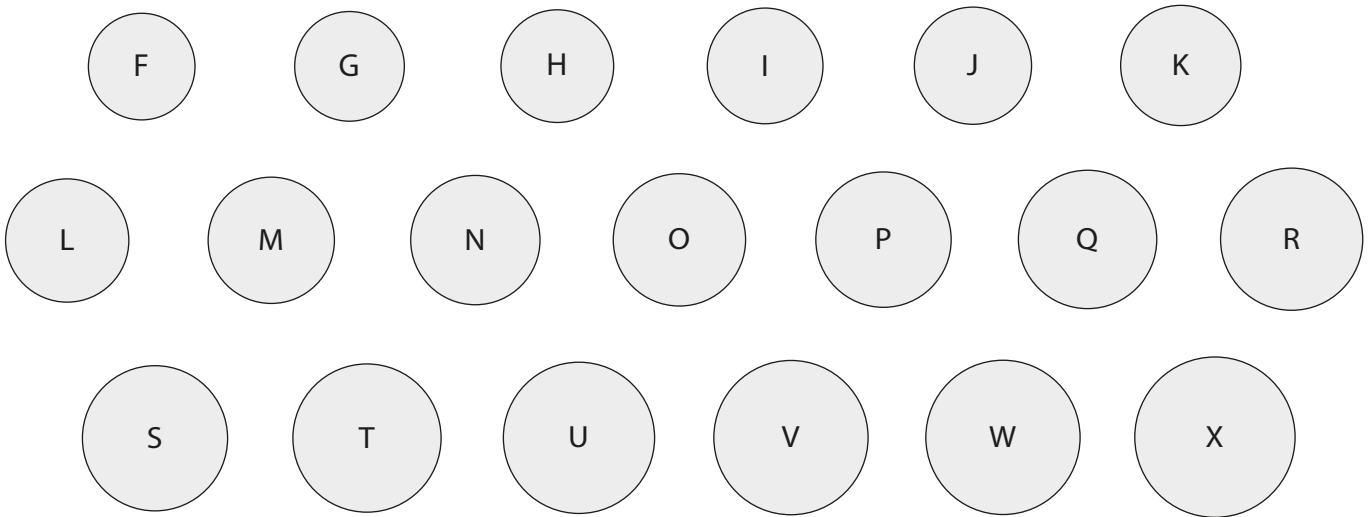


## Ring size guide / 2 options

Before printing, make sure that the page scaling is set to 'None' in your print options or you choose to print at 100%. Ensure you are printing on standard A4 sized paper (210 x 297mm).

### Option 1 / Measure an existing ring

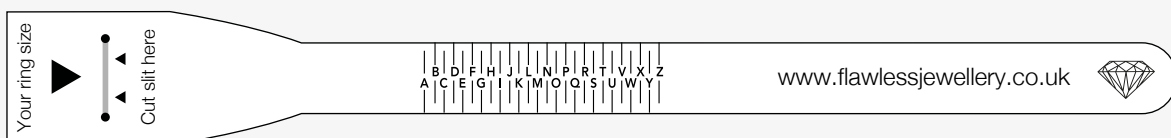
1. Find a ring that already fits the finger you would like to wear your new ring on.
2. Place the ring over the circles below until the inside circumference of the ring matches one of the circles.
3. If your ring falls in between two sizes, consider the width of the band. A wider band may require a slightly larger ring size.



### Option 2 / Use a ring sizer to measure finger

1. Print and carefully cut out the below ring sizer guide.  
(You'll know it's printed at the right size by measuring the box in grey).
2. Place the end of the ring sizer through the indicated slit to form a loop, with the letters on the outside.
3. Wrap the loop around your finger and pull to fit. The letter that appears closest to the slit is your ring size - remember to check you are able to slip it back over your knuckle for a comfortable fit.
